Mosaic is a non-profit, faith-based charity organization that serves more than 100 people with intellectual disabilities in the Pikes Peak Region. Some of you may remember it as Martin Luther Homes. The staff and volunteers are dedicated to improving, supporting and assisting their clients to achieve their own personal goals. Over the past few years there has been a shift from the group home concept to host homes. They have found that this is a much better situation for both the person, as well as the host home family. There are also day services, case management and intermittent/support services available. Mosaic has been serving the people of Colorado Springs area for 38 years. For many years we, here at Saint Luke's, have supported Mosaic by donating Christmas gifts for their annual Christmas party.
