Urban Peak Colorado Springs:

Urban Peak is a youth homeless shelter in downtown Colorado Springs. It is a 20 bed, program based facility whose mission is to provide essential services and a supportive community, empowering the residents to become self-sufficient adults. The shelter provides three meals a day, health, education and employment services. Every youth is assigned a case manager. Together they set goals and meet on a weekly basis to review their progress toward self-sufficiency.

Urban Peak also has a Permanent Supportive Housing program funded through Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Youth from El Paso County have an opportunity to transition into one of fifteen apartments where, through intensive case management, they engage in healthy living skills.

The Street Outreach Team focuses on building relationships with runaway and at-risk youth in the greater Colorado Springs area. They provide immediate resources such as water and snacks and referrals to partner organizations.
